1. Nominees must be current Missouri residents or a Missouri-based organization.
2. Missouri Humanities Council board members and staff, selection committee members and their families, and past MHC Governor's Humanities Award recipients are not eligible to be nominated.
3. Nominations must be submitted with a completed nomination form and the following:
 - **two letters of support** minimum;
 - **resume, Curriculum Vita, or summary of achievements** (3-page maximum);
 - **1 to 2 page summary** (typed) describing the reason the nominee is deserving of the award and how the nominee fits the category;
 - **additional support materials** – for the book award nomination, at least three copies of the book or publication must accompany nomination materials.

Note: Support materials may not be returned.

Deadlines: Nominations will be accepted until **Friday, April 9, 2010**. Award recipients and nominators will be notified in July 2010 of the selections.
